mowing should include weed eating and blowing

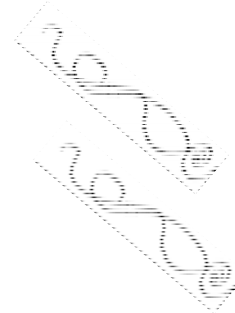
off the headstones. Bids can be submitted to the church office
