In the past there have been two trees in Sweet Springs, but one has moved to Concordia to take care of little ones in that community. I have 75-100 names on my tree and usually a waiting list. (And I know all the ones on my tree are in need of some help).

I took over the angel tree in 2005 with just 29 kids on it and it has grown ever since then, and there is nothing I love more than seeing the smiles on the kids faces when I am standing at their front door with a box full of gifts for them, or their parents with tears in their eyes and I get hugs from them all, it just warms my heart. This is my 13th year and I will continue to do as long as the Good Lord lets me.

I am asking for monetary donations if you can help out. Those donations go towards helping buy for the angels that are not adopted and also trying to even out the gifts for each kid in the family and buying gift cards to Wal-Mart for the older kids as they are so hard to buy for. This way they can get what they want.
